the events to minimize the number of people in any one area for the minimum amount of time on the premises to run your dogs for the events. As soon as you have finished your runs, please pack up and leave the grounds promptly.

*** By entering this event, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID- 19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the clubs' event, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability and possibly death. ***

- Everyone must bring and wear a face mask or face covering at all times while outside their vehicle, RV, or tent from the beginning of event check in to the completion of testing each day.
- Stay at least 6 feet away from other people who do not live with you.
- Wash hands frequently at one of the 2 hand washing stations provided or use hand sanitizer when unable to wash your hands.
- Avoid touching surfaces or objects that do not belong to you.
- Follow directions of Field Staff and signs. Stay in the designated areas until the Field Staff directs you to enter another designated area.
- Bring your own food and drinks and water for your dogs. We are NOT able to have our regular Potluck or BBQ.

General Informaton

- Dogs must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs not present for roll call 15 minutes before your assigned time slot start time will be scratched. Bitches in season, lame dogs and dogs judged unfit to compete will be excused (with entry refunded minus PayPal fee). Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered. Roll call for field committee and workers will be prioritized.
- Run ordering for Fast CATs will be assigned by the Field Test Secretary prior to the events. You will be notified of your run order number(s) for your time slot at check in. The run order is final and will not be changed. Priority for field committee dogs running will be given to free them up to work the tests.
- The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the tests.
- The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.
- NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman, except the appointed field committee.
- Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

- Control of dogs strictly enforced. Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when running.
- Clean up and dispose of all trash.
- Please pick up all dog feces and remove with trash or put in receptacle provided at site.

FAST CAT

- The field has limited shade, no cover and is fenced/gated. It can be wet.
- Battery powered, continuous loop or drag lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips or a squawker. The members of the NWRRC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test.
- Start and finish light curtain system with scoreboard will be used for accurate timing.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.
- NWRRC and its members will not be held responsible for any accidents at these tests.

For First Time Coursers and Handlers

- WHAT ARE PRE-ENTRIES? - Entries made before the closing date and time.
- INSPECTION - Dogs will be inspected by a designated Inspection Committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the Field Committee and who shall inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season). Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the Inspection Committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season shall not be allowed to enter and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded.
- ROLL CALL - The time, prior to the commencement of coursing, by which you check in with the Field Test Secretary and have your dog ready for inspection by the Inspection Committee. At Inspection, the dog is examined for lameness, and breed disqualifications (where applicable). Bitches are examined to see if they show any evidence of being in season. After Roll Call and Inspection, the dogs passing inspection will be approved to run in the order assigned per time slot on the Run Order List.
- RUN ORDER LIST - This is a posted list of the running order for the dogs participating in the event. Each dog will be given a number for their run during their time slot. A corresponding board for the current number running will be maintained, so please keep track of what number is running and be prepared to run your dog

when your number is called. Catchers should go to the finish line 2 numbers ahead of their dog's number to prevent delays between runs.

- WARM-UP, COOL-DOWN—It is highly recommended that all dogs running are walked out for about 10-15 minutes prior to and after their runs to get them warmed up and to cool them down. The cool-down is very important because it helps prevent lactic acid build-up in the muscles which leads to soreness.

For All Handlers

- All entries must check in with the Field Test Secretary at the designated Field Secretary Tent and Table. You will receive a Run Slip and an assigned run number for each entry and then proceed with your dog(s) to Inspection. Once your dog(s) pass Inspection, return to the designated parking area/open area until the Paddock Master calls for the entries in your time slot. **Stay at least 6 feet away from others at all times.** Once your time slot is called to the designated Paddock area, please remain in the Paddock area with your dog(s) during your time slot until you finish both runs (tests). Your copy of the run slip with your dog's time recorded will be placed on a table in the Paddock along with any ribbon earned. Retrieve these items and use the hand sanitizer provided to prevent contact exposure. Our staff will be wearing gloves for everyone's protection. We need to keep the number of people on the Happy Trails grounds at a minimum at all times, so please cool down walk and potty your dogs immediately after you finish your runs, pack up and leave. We cannot have people hanging out to socialize. We miss everyone too and are happy we are able to do these events, but we must maintain the requirements set forth.
- WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS A Fast CAT? - Fast CAT, unlike the CAT, is not a pass/fail, but a timed 100 yard dash after a lure through a start gate and a stop gate. The time is converted over to MPH and then multiplied by a potential handicap based on the dog's height to award points.
- CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR Fast CAT?- Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT = 150 points; DCAT = 500 points; FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree, with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.
